Policy Agreement Regarding Your Information and Ours

The integrity of your personal and/or corporate information and ours (collectively referred to as "Personal Information" and "Information" even if corporate) is important to AgLaunch Data Commons (hereinafter "**AgLaunch**"). This Policy Agreement is provided to you to describe what information may be collected about you; how your information will be used; and choices and limits you have on how your information and ours is used. AgLaunch understands that you may provide information and limits on information that you consider to be sensitive, and to protect your data and ours, use of these systems, website, and applications for Data Commons (hereinafter "**Platform**") are always subject to this Policy. "You" and "yours" means you and your organization. "Our" and "Ours" means AgLaunch and those persons who are responsible for managing it, including contractors working under the direction of AgLaunch.

Changes to this Policy will be posted on the website in a timely manner.

Your Consent

By using the Platform, you agree with the terms of this Policy. Whenever you use the Platform, you consent to the collection, use, and disclosure of that information in accordance with this Policy.

References in this Policy to "we" means AgLaunch, the Platform itself and those persons who are responsible for managing it, including contractors working under the direction of AgLaunch.

This Policy applies to the Platform. We are not responsible for your information on other websites once you leave the Platform.

You should read the Policy at each website that you visit after you leave the Platform.

I. Personal Information That is Collected

This section of the Policy discusses the different types of information that may be collected about you and the ways in which that information is collected.

Information Collected From Visitors

Visitors to the Platform can access the home page and browse some areas of the website without disclosing any personally identifiable information. We may track information provided to us by your browser, including the referring URL, your browser type, the time and date of access, and other information that does not personally identify you. However, you must register with us to use portions of the website.

Information We Collect When You Enroll

Persons enrolling in the Platform are asked to provide identifying information, such as contact information. This information will include information concerning your demographic characteristics and farming operation. It may also include other information concerning other persons with a partnership interest in your farm. Enrollment may feature required and optional information.

Other Information

We may collect information that you voluntarily provide to us through responses to surveys, polling, questionnaires, and the like.

We may ask you to provide additional information such as your email address if you want to obtain additional services or information or to resolve complaints or concerns.

In addition, we gather information about you that is automatically collected by our web infrastructure, such as your IP address, domain name and/or mobile device identifier. The Platform may use this information to personalize its offerings and presentations to you, facilitate your movements throughout our websites, provide personalized services, and communicate with you individually.

Use of Cookies and Other Tracking Systems

Cookies are a technology used by the Platform to identify a user as the user moves through the website. Your browser allows us to place some information on your device for identification. Cookies are used to personalize the website and to track your usage across it.

Your web browser can be set to allow you to control whether you will accept cookies, reject cookies, or to notify you each time a cookie is sent to you. If your browser is set to reject cookies, websites that are

cookie enabled will not recognize you when you return to the website, and some website functionality may be lost. For example, the Platform may not be able to authenticate you, and you may not be able to access parts of it.

On occasion, the Platform may interface with third parties that may place cookies on your device. In those instances, we will require these third parties to observe this Policy.

The help section of your browser will tell you how to prevent your browser from accepting cookies.

Cookies do not normally contain personally identifiable information. If you have provided us information about yourself, the Platform may associate your registration information with cookies referenced on your device. Associating a cookie with your registration information allows the Platform to provide increased personalization and functionality.

II. Personal Information Usage

This section of the Policy identifies the ways we may use collected information.

License to Use Farmer Data

Farmer grants to AgLaunch a non-exclusive, license to copy, publish, distribute, and prepare derivative works of Farmer Data for the purposes of (i) monitoring, improving, and correcting the performance of the Data Commons Platform, developing enhancements to the Data Commons Platform, developing new products, and other internal business purposes; (ii) compiling statistical information (including without limitation aggregating Farmer Data with other data); (iii) aggregating Farmer Data with other data; and (iv) creating Deidentified Data. Farmer acknowledges that AgLaunch shall distribute Deidentified Data, which contains Farmer Data that has been deidentified or anonymized, to authorized 3rd parties. AgLaunch and the Data Commons Steering Committee shall have sole and exclusive responsibility, exercising their own judgement, for approving or disapproving such agreement with 3rd parties. AgLaunch will exercise reasonable business judgement for monitoring and ensuring such 3rd parties abide by such contracts that include access to Deidentified Data.

Disposition of Farmer Data

Upon Farmer's written request within 30 days following the expiration or any termination of this Agreement, AgLaunch shall destroy the Farmer Data ; provided, however, that to the extent AgLaunch is required by applicable law or legal process to retain any portion of the Farmer Data, AgLaunch shall retain such Farmer Data as though it were Confidential Information for such time as is required by such law or after which AgLaunch promptly shall destroy the Farmer Data. Within 30 days following the written request of a farmer to delete Farmer Data within the Data Commons, AgLaunch will respond with confirmation of request and the date that all data that is associated with the Farmer will be removed. Any Farmer Data previously released to an Authorized 3rd Party, cannot be deleted by AgLaunch and a separate request to the 3rd Party shall be made by the Farmer. If the Farmer removes their Farmer Data from the Data Commons Platform, the Farmer waives their rights to the

AgLaunch Farm Trials, access to the Data Commons Platform, and ultimately participation in the AgLaunch Farmers, LLC.

III. Protection of Personal Information

How the Platform Handles Privacy Internally

This section of the Policy discusses the security measures that will be taken to protect information that is collected about you.

Security

The Platform uses customary security methods to determine the identity of registered users so that appropriate rights and restrictions can be enforced for that user. Reliable verification of a user's identity is called authentication. The Platform utilizes usernames, passwords, and unique identifiers to authenticate. In certain restricted and limited situations, IP addresses may be used for authentication. Users are responsible for maintaining the confidentiality and security of authentication data.

AgLaunch is committed to operating its website and systems with customary internal controls and the highest ethical standards. The AgLaunch and the Platform uses reasonably available information security measures and techniques to protect users' data. However, transmitting information over the internet is never completely secure and additionally, any computers linked to the internet run the risk of being hacked, and thus your information runs the risk of being intercepted, collected, used or disclosed by others. AgLaunch cannot and does not guarantee complete security.

Third Parties

In addition to aggregated information discussed above, the Platform may share some kinds of information with third parties as described below.

Companies and People Who Work for AgLaunch: AgLaunch partners with other companies and individuals to assist in providing services. For example, the AgLaunch has contracted The Seam LLC to assist in the design, creation, and maintenance of the Platform. AgLaunch also partners with other consultants to assist in the management of the Platform and its objectives. AgLaunch may also host its website on another entity's devices, hire technical consultants to maintain the website and systems, or work with companies to remove repetitive information from customer lists, analyze data, provide marketing assistance, and provide customer service. In order to perform their jobs, these other entities and consultants may have limited access to some of the personal information the Platform maintains about the users. AgLaunch requires all such entities and consultants to comply with the terms of this Policy, to limit their access to any personal information to the minimum necessary to perform their services, and not to use the information they may access for purposes other than fulfilling their responsibilities to AgLaunch. We use our best efforts to limit the use of other entities and consultants in areas where personally identifiable information may be involved.

Legal Requirements: AgLaunch may release account and other personal information when we believe release is required to comply with any relevant law. AgLaunch may release such information, if, in our judgment, the release is compelled by law or regulation, the release may be necessary to prevent violation of law or serious injury, or the information is not confidential.

IV. Your Privacy Choices

When you complete registration, you may be given the option of receiving informational/promotional emails from AgLaunch and/or third parties. You may opt-out from receiving these emails at any time. You can unsubscribe from such emails by following the unsubscribe instructions on such email or contacting customer support with contact information provided within the Platform.

V. Updating Your Personal Information

You have access to your personal contact information so that you may update the contact that you have provided to us.

VI. Protection of Our Proprietary Information

As a user of the Platform, you agree that the software and related technologies that enable and power the Platform are owned by The Seam LLC and you agree not to copy or reproduce the application platform, software, graphics, design, format, its look and feel, appearance, features, or any part thereof.
